Finding:

Recite 713.A Based on record review: The Provider lacked documentation of a current annual inspection and approval from City Fire. The last approval expired on 1/31/18. Documentation reflect a City Fire inspection was completed on 4/20/2018; however due to violations a certificate was not issued.

1721-A.-C.: Continuing Education Training

- 1721-A.-C.: A. Early learning centers shall provide opportunities for continuing education of staff members who are left alone with children, or who have supervisory or disciplinary authority over children.
- 1. Staff members of early learning centers, excluding foster grandparents, shall obtain a minimum of 12 clock hours of continuing education per center anniversary year.
- B. Staff members of type I, type II and type III centers who are neither left alone with children, nor have supervisory or disciplinary authority over children, shall obtain a minimum of three clock hours of continuing education in job related topics per center's anniversary year.
- C. Continuing education for all types of centers shall be conducted by trainers approved by the Licensing Division. The Licensing Division shall keep a registry of approved trainers.

Finding:

Recite: 1721-A.-C. Based on record review: There was no documentation that the center staff, S3 (7 hours), S5 (3 hours), S6 (10 hours) and S8 (0 hours), of a Type III centers, excluding Foster Grandparents, obtained a minimum of 12 clock hours of training annually in the topics found in 1719(A) and (B) conducted by trainers approved by the Licensing Division. This is in addition to the required training from the Department of Health, Pediatric First Aid and Infant/Child/Adult CPR. Provider stated trainings are scheduled to be completed on 5/16/2019 & 5/17/2018
