1725-A.-E.: Medication Management Training

1725-A.-E.:

- A. Begining July 1, 2016 All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.
- B. Whether administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration.
- C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved Child Care Health Consultant.
- D. A licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

Finding:

1725-A.-E. Based on record review: After July 1, 2016, the provider did not have at least two staff members trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not. S7 stated she still does not have a date scheduled for this training through DHH in Plaquemines Parish. S7 advised to seek this training through Orleans or Jefferson Parish

1903-E.6: Outdoor - Crawlspaces

1903-E.6: Crawlspaces and mechanical, electrical, or other hazardous equipment shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1903-E.6 Based on observations: Crawlspaces are not inaccessible to children as Specialist observed the plastic lattice which runs along the lower section of the center building within the outdoor play area has become unsecured in some areas. The plastic ties attaching it to the building have broken in two pieces. Children could possible become entrapped under the center building if not properly supervised.
