

Statement of Deficiencies

1915-B.&C: Health Services - Parental Notification

Not Met

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B. Reporting. Incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior shall be documented and reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence.

C. Immediate Notification. The parent shall be immediately notified in the following circumstances:

1. blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
2. head or neck or eye injury;
3. human bite that breaks the skin;
4. animal bite;
5. impaled object;
6. broken or dislodged teeth;
7. allergic reaction skin changes (e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.);
8. unusual breathing;
9. symptoms of dehydration;
10. temperature reading over 101° oral, 102° rectal, or 100° axillary; or
11. injury or illness requiring professional medical attention.

Finding:

1915-B.Health Services- Parental Notification: Based on Record Review: The center's documentation of incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior did not have documentation that it was reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence. The incident occurred at an unknown time but was observed by S12 and S14 at 3:30PM on 4/09/2018 and the parent was not notified when C1 was released on 4/09/2018. The center completed an incident form on 4/10/2018 one day after the incident occurred after speaking to the parent.
