

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

#### Finding:

1725.A.-C. Based on record review:

Staff trained in administering medication, S1, S3, S5, S9 and S10, did not have current documentation of training in medication administration completed with an approved Child Care Health Consultant. Training is required every two years and the staff's training expired April 2018. A training class has been scheduled for 5/11/19.

### 1907.E.2.: Cribs Free of Toys and Other Soft or Loose Bedding

Not Met

1907.E.2.: Cribs shall be free of toys and other soft or loose bedding, including comforters, blankets, sheets, bumper pads, pillows, stuffed animals and wedges when the child is in the crib.

#### Finding:

1907.E.2. Based on record review:

The center's cribs were not free of toys or other soft or loose bedding (including comforters, blankets, sheets, bumper pads, pillows, stuffed animals and wedges) while the child was in the crib as evidence by: the Specialist observed during the initial walk through of the center at 11:30 am, 3 children in the 3-8 month old classroom with blankets in the cribs while the children were sleeping in the cribs. This was immediately corrected.

### 1909.G.: Infant - Bibs

Not Met

1909.G.: Bibs shall not be worn by any child while asleep.

#### Finding:

1909.G. Based on observations: Children were allowed to wear a bib while asleep. The Specialist observed during the initial walk through of the center at 11:30 am, 2 children in the 3-8 month old classroom wearing bibs while sleeping in cribs. This was immediately corrected.
