

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1723.A.&B.: CPR Certification

Not Met

1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

#### Finding:

1723.A.&B.: CPR Certification: Based on record review at approximately 10:30am, the provider failed to have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. 2 of 8 staff had documentation of this certification. Provider needs to have at least 2 more staff trained in CPR.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective today, S1 stated she will talk with the owner of the daycare to have the training scheduled immediately so that the deficiency is not recited.

### 1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid

Not Met

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

#### Finding:

1723.C. Pediatric First Aid: Based on record review at approximately 10:30am, the provider failed to have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid through training approved by the department. 2 of 8 staff had documentation of this certification. Provider needs to have at least 2 more staff trained in Pediatric First Aid.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective today, S1 stated she will talk with the owner of the daycare to have the training scheduled immediately so that the deficiency is not recited

### 1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

#### Finding:

1725.A.-C. Medication Management Training: Based on record review at approximately 10:30am, the provider failed to have at least two staff members trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective today, S1 stated she will talk with the owner of the daycare to have the training scheduled immediately so that the deficiency is not recited.
