713.A. Based on record review/interview(s) at approximately 12:30 p.m, S1 failed to have documentation of a current annual inspection and approval from Office of Public Health. The date of the last approval is 8/17/2020. S1 stated, the center was closed March 2020 to August 2021 due to Covid and Health did not come out to do their inspection.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 4/29/2022, S1 stated, she will set a 90 day reminder for when the center's anniversary is approaching to call and email Office of Public Health, to ensure that inspections are current and completed timely, so this deficiency is not cited again.
