

Statement of Deficiencies

1723.A.&B.: CPR Certification - Infant/Child

Not Met

1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. All staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. All staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

CPR Certification

Finding:

1723.A.&B.: Based on record review at 1:30 p.m., S1 failed to have documentation that all staff members on the premises of the center and accessible to children have current certification in infant, child, and adult CPR through training approved by the department. S4 failed to have current CPR training. S6, Compliance Coordinator, stated he has a CPR class scheduled on July 15, 2022 for staff without current CPR training.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 4/28/2022, S6 stated that he will create a spreadsheet and set a reminder 30 days prior to the expiration of certification to ensure compliance with this regulation.

1723.C: Pediatric First Aid

1723.C: C. All staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

1723.C: Based on record review at 1:30 p.m., S1 failed to have documentation that all staff members on the premises of the center and accessible to children have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department. S4 failed to have current pediatric first aid training.
