

## ***Statement of Deficiencies***

### **1903.E.5.: Outdoor - Enclosed**

**Not Met**

1903.E.5.: Outdoor play space shall be enclosed with a permanent fence or other permanent barrier in a manner that protects children from traffic hazards, prevents children from leaving the premises without proper supervision, and prevents contact with animals or unauthorized persons.

#### **Finding:**

1903.E.5. Based on observations/interview(s): Specialist observed that the fence on the play yard was missing the bottom half of one of the boards. The board looks as if someone had tried to kick the entire board down. The bottom half of the board was laying on the ground and the other piece of the board had a sharp piece of the wood sticking out. The entire board was not down, however, the play yard did not prevent children from leaving the premises whereas a child could squeeze through the broken part of the fence. S1 stated that she was not aware and that she would ensure that the fence gets fixed immediately.
