

Statement of Deficiencies

1913.A.: Water Activity / Water Play Authorization

Not Met

1913.A.: The center shall obtain written parental authorization for a child to participate in any water activities or water play activities as those activities are defined in §103.

Finding:

1913.A. Based on record review 05/02/2019, The provider lacked written authorization from the parent for the child to participate in water activities or water play activities as those activities are defined in Section 103. in 10 of 10 children's files reviewed. S1 stated she will get authorization from parents for this summer water activities.

1919.A.&B.: Food Service and Nutrition - Menu

Not Met

1919.A.&B.: A. All meals and snacks provided by the center, and their preparation, service and storage, shall meet the requirements for meals of the U. S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP), 7 CFR 226.20, and LAC 51:XXIII.

B. The weekly menu shall:

1. be planned for each day of the week and list the specific food items served;
2. be prominently posted by the first day of each week and remain posted throughout the week; and
3. have substitutions or additions posted on or near the menu.

Finding:

1919.B.3: Based on observations on 05/02/2019, menu substitutions or additions were not posted on or near the menus as evidenced by the lunch menu states the center was serving spaghetti with meat sauce, green beans, sliced pears, and milk. The center served each child a Wacky Pack from Sonic. The children were about to choose food item (corn dog, hamburger, cheese burger, grilled cheese sandwich) the wanted in the Wacky Pack. S1 stated they reward the children with the Wacky Pack sometimes. The menu was updated while specialist was present.
