Based on record review/interview: At approximately 12:18pm, S1 failed to have documentation that all staff on the premises and accessible to the children, have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. Two out of thirty-eight staff did not have documentation of this certification. S1 stated she has both of them scheduled CPR training in June 2022.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 5/3/2022, S1 stated she will start registering staff upon hire for CPR certification if they do not have it already, to ensure compliance with this regulation.
