

Statement of Deficiencies

1901-G.&H.: Equipment

Not Met

1901-G.&H.: All equipment used by children shall be maintained in a clean and safe condition and in good repair. Moveable equipment shall be secured and supported so that it shall not fall or tip over.

Finding:

1901 G & H Based on observation: All of the center's equipment used by children was not maintained in a safe condition and in good repair. Specialist observed two tricycles with open handlebar ends exposing children to being scratched, two plastic, ride-on cars that were cracked on the handlebars, and one slide of the plastic jungle gym cracked near the bottom of the slide that may cause injury to children. O1 came into the center at 11:17am with repair patches for the slide. S1 stated the slide would be repaired by next licensing visit.

1911-G: Pacifier Attached

Not Met

1911-G: Pacifiers attached to strings or ribbons shall not be placed around the neck or attached to the clothing of a child.

Finding:

1911-G Based on observations: A pacifier that was attached to strings or ribbons was attached to the clothing of a child. S4 removed the pacifier from the clothing during the licensing visit.

1919-H: Infants Held While Bottle Fed

Not Met

1919-H: Infants that cannot hold a bottle shall be held while being bottle-fed. A child shall not be placed lying down on a mat or otherwise with a bottle, sippy cup, etc. A bottle shall not be propped at any time.

Finding:

1919-H Based on observations:
Specialist observed a child, C1, in crib with his bottle.
