## Not Met

1713-E&F:

E: While supervising a group of children, staff shall devote their time to supervising the children, meeting the needs of the children, and participating with them in their activities.

F: Staff duties that include cooking, housekeeping or administrative functions shall not interfere with the supervision of children.

## Finding:

1713 E & F Based on observation: While supervising a group of children, childcare staff did not devote their time to supervision of the children, meeting the needs of the children, and/or in participation with the children in their activities.

Specialist observed S9 on her cellular phone at 11:31 am while 4 children in her class were sleeping and two children were on their mats resting (not sleeping). Specialist also observed, at 12:34 pm, S2 sitting at her desk with a white earpiece in her ear paying attention to her phone that was on, on her desk, while children were napping. Specialist informed S1 that staff should devote their time to supervising children, whether sleeping or not.
