Statement of Deficiencies

1507-A: Daily Attendance Records - Children

1507-A: A daily attendance record for children shall be maintained that shall:

- 1. include the child's first and last name, arrival and departure times, and first and last name of person or entity to whom the child is released;
- 2. accurately reflect children on the center premises at any given time; and
- 3. be used to sign in and out if a child leaves and returns to the center during the day.

Finding:

1507-A Based on record review: Daily attendance record maintained by computer program failed to show the person to whom child is released when a staff clocked out C11 at departure on 4/21/17 and 5/1/17.

1901-C: End-of-Day Check

1901-C: The entire center and play yard shall be checked after the last child departs to ensure that no child is left at the center and this check shall be documented. Documentation shall include date, time of visual check, and signature of the staff conducting the visual check.

Finding:

1901-C Based on record review: There failed to be evidence of end of the day check completed on the days of operation on 5/1/17, 4/20/17, and 3/9/17.

1903-E.5: Outdoor - Enclosed

1903-E.5: Outdoor play space shall be enclosed with a permanent fence or other permanent barrier in a manner that protects children from traffic hazards, prevents children from leaving the premises without proper supervision, and prevents contact with animals or unauthorized persons.

Finding:

1903-E.5 Based on observations: Wooden fence on side of building has a hole at the bottom which is large enough for animals to enter play yard.
