

Statement of Deficiencies

1509.A.9.: Electronic Devices Policy

Not Met

1509.A.9.: Electronic Devices Policy that provides that all activities involving electronic devices, including but not limited to television, movies, games, videos, computers and hand held electronic devices, shall adhere to the following limitations:

- a. electronic device activities for children under age two are prohibited; and
- b. time allowed for electronic device activities for children ages two and above shall not exceed two hours per day, with the exception that television, DVD, or video viewing shall be limited to no more than one hour per day;

Finding:

** NEW ** 1509.A.9. Based on observations:

S1 and S2 did not follow the Electronic Devices Policy as Electronic Devices were used by children under age 2.

- Specialist observed S1 and S2's class, which included one infant and four 1 year old children, sitting in a group watching the television/laptop at 10:27am.

1911.I.&J.: Proper Lifting of a Child

Not Met

1911.I.&J.: I. Staff members shall adhere to proper techniques for lifting a child.

J. Staff members shall not lift a child by one or both arms.

Finding:

** NEW ** 1911 I&J Based on observation: S1 did not lift a child, age 1, using proper lifting techniques as Specialist observed the one year old child fall. After the child fell, S1 lifted the child pulling only his right forearm in an upward position resulting in the child to lift up to his feet.
