7305-D Based on observations/interview(s): The Provider lacked documentation of a current annual inspection and approval from the Office of Public Health, Sanitarian Services. The provider stated they are currently in the process of getting grease and an air brake installed to complete an approval from the Office of Public Health, Sanitarian Services.

7312-E.1: CPR Not Met

7312-E.1: A minimum of at least 50 percent of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children at all times shall have documentation of current infant/child/adult certification in CPR. Original cards shall be made available upon request. This training shall be approved by the Department of Social Services prior to acceptance.

7312-E.1 Based on record review/interview(s): The Provider did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children have current approved Infant/Child/Adult certification in CPR. 2 of 6 staff had documentation of this certification. The provider stated that all staff had currently taken the class on 4/17/2014 but the cards have not come in.
