

Statement of Deficiencies

1723.A.&B.: CPR Certification

Not Met

1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1723.A.&B: Based on record review on 05/09/2019, the provider did not have fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, with current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. 3 of 4 staff had documentation of this certification. Provider is schedule to have a CPR training class on 05/22/19.

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid

Not Met

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1723.A.&B: Based on record review on 05/09/2019, the provider did not have fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, with current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department. 3 of 4 staff had documentation of this certification. Provider is schedule to have a CPR training class on 05/22/19.

1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725.B. Based on record review and interviews on 05/09/2019, the provider did not have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. Provider stated during the training the instructor got sick and could not complete the training. Provider stated they will reschedule the training with NSU.

1903.C.: Free of Hazards

Not Met

1903.C.: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

Finding:

1903.C. Based on observations 05/09/2019, the center's indoor area was not free of hazards as evidenced by classroom 2 has a leak in the roof. S1 stated she notified the executive director this morning.
