Based on observation/record review: The current weekly snack menu listing specific food items served for each day of the week was not prominently posted by the first day of each week and remain posted throughout the week. S1 stated children bring their own lunch to the preschool and each child has a day to bring snacks for their class. There is no planned menu for the snacks to be served.
