

Statement of Deficiencies

1719-A.-B.: Orientation Training

Not Met

1719-A.-B.: Within seven calendar days of date of hire, and prior to assuming sole responsibility for any children, each staff member shall receive orientation to the policies and practices of the center that at a minimum shall include:

1. child abuse identification and reporting;
2. emergency preparation;
3. licensing regulations; and
4. safe sleep practices,

Within 30 calendar days of date of hire, each staff member shall receive orientation to the additional policies and practices of the center that at a minimum shall include:

1. child development;
2. child guidance;
3. learning activities;
4. health and safety;
5. shaken baby prevention;

Finding:

1719-A.-B.: Based on record review: The center lacked documentation that 2 of 22 staff, S20 and S22, received orientation training within seven days of date of hire to include the topics of child abuse identification and reporting, emergency preparation, licensing regulations, and safe sleep practices.

1915-A: Health Services - Observation

Not Met

1915-A: Observation. Upon arrival at the center, the physical condition of each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises or injuries, and when something is observed, it shall be documented and such documentation shall include an explanation from the parent or child.

Finding:

RECITED: 1915-A Based on record review: The provider did not document observations, when something is observed, noted on children upon arrival to the center. Results including an explanation from parent and/or child were not documented. Health observations upon arrival was not completed for the Toddler classroom for the following days: 1 out of 7 children on 5/1/17, 5 out of 7 children on 5/3/17, 5/4/17, 5/5/17, 5/8/17, 5/9/17, and 5/10/17.
