Based on record review/interview at 2:51 pm, S1 failed to have documentation that all staff on the premises and accessible to the children have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. 10 of 11 staff had documentation of this certification. S1 stated S4 is unable to take the certification course because of a language barrier as S4 speaks an indigenous language.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 05/18/2022, S1 stated she will ensure that staff that does not have the certification will not be permitted on premises and to ensure compliance with this regulation.
