Statement of Deficiencies

1713.A.-C.: Supervision

1713.A.-C.: A: Children shall be supervised at all times in the center, on the playground, on field trips, on non-vehicular excursions, and during all water activities and water play activities.

B: Children shall not be left alone in any room, (except the restroom as indicated in Subsection G of this Section or when being provided services by therapeutic professionals, as deficed in 103), outdoors, or in vehicles, even momentarily, without staff present.

C: A staff person shall be assigned to supervise specific children whose names and whereabouts that staff person shall know and with whom the staff person shall be physically present. Staff shall be able to state how many children are in their care at all times.

Finding:

1713.A.-C. Based on observations on 5/23/19, children were not under supervision at all times as evidenced by L/S reviewed video footage from 5/2/19 from 11:06am to 11:18am and S21 is observed leaving C1 unsupervised on 3 occasions and leaving C2 unsupervised on 1 occasion. (1st) S21 is walking down the preschool hallway toward the classrooms. S20 has C1 in the classroom doorway as he is about to be picked up for the day. S21 is coming to assist S20 because C1 has been misbehaving in the classroom. Before S21 makes it to the classroom C1 takes off running down the hallway at 11:06am. S21 leaves C1 on the hallway and enters S20's classroom for about 5 seconds. C1 runs into another classroom and S21 goes to the classroom to get him and bring him back into the hallway. (2nd) S21 is observed walking with her back to C1 down the hallway giving attendance forms to another child. (3rd) S21 is in the hallway retrieving C1's backpack while her view of C1 is blocked by a stack of sleeping cots. S21 picked C1 up and takes him back into his classroom leaving C2 in the hallway unsupervised. Based on video footage from 3 different angles there was not any other staff persons on the hallway at either occasion of C1 or C2 being unsupervised.

1911.I.&J.: Proper Lifting of a Child
