

Statement of Deficiencies

1909-D: Infants - Car Seats

Not Met

1909-D: Written authorization from a physician is required for a child to sleep in a car seat or other similar device and shall include the amount of time that the child is allowed to remain in said device.

Finding:

1909-D Based on observations: Written authorization from a physician was not available for 2 of 5 infants as required for infant to sleep in a car seat or other similar device. There was also no authorization to include the amount of time that the children in the positioning devices; swings, were allowed to remain in said device. On 05/24/2017 specialist observed during the walk thorough, 2 infants; C1 and C2 asleep in positioning devices. Explained that in order for children to sleep in positioning devices there has to written authorization from a physician. S4 explained that the child had stomach issues and that was the reason. Specialist explained that, that was understandable, but reiterated they needed to secure written authorization.
