Statement of Deficiencies

1711.A.&B.&D.&G.: Child to Staff Ratio

Not Met

1711.A.&B.&D.&G.: A. Child to staff ratios are established to ensure the safety of all children.

- B. Minimum child to staff ratios shall be met at all times.
- 1. There shall be a minimum of two staff members present at an early learning center when more than four children are present.
- 2. Only those staff members directly providing care, supervision or guidance to children shall be counted in the child to staff ratios.
- C. The department's form noting required child-to-staff ratios shall be posted in each room included in the center?s licensed capacity.
- D. Minimum child-to-staff ratios for type II and type III centers are as follows.

- G. Mixed Age Groups? Minimum Child to Staff Ratios
- 1. An average of the child to staff ratios may be applied to mixed age groups of children ages two, three, four and five.
- 2. Child to staff ratios for children under age two are excluded from averaging.
- 3. When a mixed age group includes children younger than age two, the age of the youngest child determines the child to staff ratio for the group.
- 4. An average may be applied to a mixed age group consisting only of children ages five and older.

Finding:

1711.A.&B. Based on observation at 9:45 a.m., S1 failed to meet the required child to staff ratio for children of the following ages: 8 children, ages one to two years old, with 1 staff person. The required ratio for children of this age is 7 children per 1 staff person. S1 immediately removed one child from the classroom which corrected the ratio.

CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: Effective 5/24/2022, S1 will review the child to staff ratios with all staff by 12:00 p.m. on 5/25/2022 and will also monitor each classroom during morning drop off time daily to ensure compliance with this regulation.

1723.A.&B.: CPR Certification - Infant/Child

1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. All staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. All staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

Based on record review at 11:00 a.m., S1 failed to have documentation that all staff on the premises and accessible to the children have current certification in infant, child, and adult CPR through training approved by the department. 1 of 11 staff failed to have this documentation. S1 has scheduled S11 to complete CPR training through an approved provider by the department on 06/09/2022.

CORRECTION ACTION PLAN: Effective 5/24/2022, S1 has scheduled all new staff and S11 to complete CPR training through an approved provider by the department on 06/09/2022. S1 will monitor the CPR certifications for all staff quarterly to ensure compliance with this regulation.

1723.C: Pediatric First Aid Not Met

1723.C: C. All staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1723.C. Based on record review at 11:00 a.m., S1 failed to have documentation that all staff on the premises and accessible to the children have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department. 1 of 11 staff failed to have this documentation. S1 has scheduled S11 to complete First Aid training through an approved provider by the department on 06/09/2022.

CORRECTION ACTION PLAN: Effective 5/24/2022, S1 has scheduled all new staff and S11 to complete First Aid training through an approved provider by the department on 06/09/2022. S1 will monitor the First Aid certifications for all staff quarterly to ensure compliance with this regulation.

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Statement of Deficiencies

1909.I.: Availability of Safety Approved Cribs

Not Met

1909.I.: A safety approved crib shall be available for each infant.

Finding:

1909.I. Based on observations at 9:50 a.m., S1 failed to have a safety approved crib available for each infant. 9 infants were present but only 7 cribs were available.

CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: Effective 5/24/2022, S1 will purchase 3 new cribs today so that all infants enrolled in the center will have a safety approved crib available to ensure compliance with this regulation.
