

Statement of Deficiencies

1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725.A.: Medication Management Training: Based on record review, on 5/27/2020, Specialist observed S3 did not have current documentation of training in medication administration completed with an approved Child Care Health Consultant. A review of the Medication Authorization form showed that S3 administered medication to C1, age 1, nineteen times from 2/19/2020 to 3/20/2020.

Corrective Action Plan: S1 stated S3 is scheduled to complete the Medication Administration Training with a Child Care Health Consultant on 5/27/2020. Once this training is complete, all employed staff will have current training in medication administration.
