1911.G. Based on observations on 05/28/2019, specialist observed a pacifier attached to to the clothing of C1 at 10:40 AM. Per S4's statement, the mother attaches the pacifier to the child upon arrival to the center. S4 removed at 10:41 AM.

1919.A.&B.: Food Service and Nutrition - Menu

1919.A.&B.: A. All meals and snacks provided by the center, and their preparation, service and storage, shall meet the requirements for meals of the U. S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP), 7 CFR 226.20, and LAC 51:XXIII.

- B. The weekly menu shall:
- 1. be planned for each day of the week and list the specific food items served;
- 2. be prominently posted by the first day of each week and remain posted throughout the week; and
- 3. have substitutions or additions posted on or near the menu.

Finding:

1919.A.&B: Based on observations/record review on 05/28/2019, the center's lunch failed to meet the requirements for meals of the USDA Child and Adult Care Program as evidenced by specialist observed S1 serving the children Meat Pizza, Corn, and Lemonade for lunch at 11:00 AM. S1 failed to serve an additional vegetable or fruit and milk. Per the center's menu, Meat Pizza, Corn, Applesauce, Jello, and Milk were to be served. Per S1's statement, the children did not drink the milk on 05/24/2019 so she did not offer it today. She also stated that she did not have applesauce or any other food to substitute the applesauce. This was not corrected prior to specialist departure.
