1711.H.: Rest Time - Minimum Child to Staff Ratio

Not Met

1711.H.: Rest Time - Minimum Child to Staff Ratios

1. Sufficient staffing needed to satisfy child to staff ratios shall be present on the premises during rest time and available to assist as needed.
2. Children ages one and older may be grouped together at rest time with one staff member in each room supervising the resting children.

Finding:

1711.H. Based on observations/record review: S1 did not have the required staffing present in the building during rest time to satisfy child/staff ratio. Specialist arrived at the Center and pulled into the parking lot at 11:35am and observed S1 pulling into the parking lot at the same time. S1 entered the building and then the Specialist. Specialist observed S1 at the front entrance with a five year old child. Specialist conducted a walk through immediately following entrance to the building and observed S2 standing in the doorway between two rooms supervising fifteen 2-9 year old children in one room and seven 1-2 year olds children in the other room. Specialist continued the walk through and observed S3 supervising three infant to one year old children in a separate classroom. Specialist reviewed the Staff Daily Attendance and observed S2 and S3 were the only staff present in the Center from 11:52:00am to 11:54:31am. S1 would need one additional staff present in the Center during this time to meet the minimum rest time child to staff ratio.
