- 2. accurately reflect children on the center premises at any given time; and
- 3. be used to sign in and out if a child leaves and returns to the center during the day.

Finding:

1507.A. Based on record review:

There was no documentation of a daily attendance record for C1 that included the time of arrival and departure of each child and the first and last name of the person to whom the child was released. S8 was unable to locate any attendance record for C1 during the licensing visit. S8 was looking for the attendance record at approximately 12:00 pm-12:22 pm.

1723.A.&B.: CPR Certification

1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.
