

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1901-G.-H.: Equipment

Not Met

1901-G.-H.: G. All equipment used by children shall be maintained in a clean and safe condition and in good repair.  
H. Moveable equipment shall be secured and supported so that it shall not fall or tip over.

#### Finding:

1901-G.-H. Based on observations/interview on 6/13/18: All of the center equipment used by children was not maintained in a clean and safe condition and in good repair. Specialists observed play yard equipment in the 1 yr old play yard disassembled in pieces on the play yard. Specialists brought it to the attention of S1. S1 stated the lawn care worker knocked it over this past weekend when cutting the grass. S1 stated that the children have not gone outside this week due to weather and the play yard equipment would be reassembled prior to the children going out to the play yard.

### 1911-K: Hand Washing

Not Met

1911-K: Staff and children shall wash their hands using soap at least at the following times: upon arrival at the center, before preparing or serving meals, before giving medication, after playing in water used by more than one person, after toileting, after helping a child use a toilet or changing diapers, after wiping noses or cleaning wounds, after handling pets and other animals, after playing in sandboxes, before eating meals or snacks, upon coming in from outdoors, after cleaning or handling garbage and anytime hands become soiled with body fluids, such as urine, saliva, blood or nasal discharge.

#### Finding:

1911-K Based on observations on 6/13/18: Staff did not wash their hands with soap as needed. Licensing Specialist observed that S5 did not wash their hands after changing an infant. Specialist observed that after S5 changed one infants diaper, she then picked up another infant without washing washing her hands.
