

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1915.B.&C.: Health Services - Parental Notification

Not Met

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B. Reporting. Incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior shall be documented and reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence.

C. Immediate Notification. The parent shall be immediately notified in the following circumstances:

1. blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
2. head or neck or eye injury;
3. human bite that breaks the skin;
4. animal bite;
5. impaled object;
6. broken or dislodged teeth;
7. allergic reaction skin changes (e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.);
8. unusual breathing;
9. symptoms of dehydration;
10. temperature reading over 101° oral, 102° rectal, or 100° axillary; or
11. injury or illness requiring professional medical attention.

#### Finding:

1915.B.&C.:Based on interview: The provider did not have documentation of incidents of incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behaviors as on 05/28/2019 at 11:00am S4, S5, and S6 observed that C1, a one year old's left ponytail was cut off. Notification was not made immediately or when the child was released to the parent on the day of the observation 05/28/2019 at 6:14pm.

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
