Statement of Deficiencies

5305-I: Staff Attendance

5305.I. A daily attendance record for staff, including the director/owner, to include the time of arrival and departure shall be maintained. Staff shall document in/out when not on the child care premises. This record shall accurately reflect persons on the child care premises at any given time.

Finding:

5305.I. The center's staff daily attendance record did not accurately reflect persons on the child care premises at any given time as evidenced by the Director and Director Designee not documenting their own attendance at the center.

5311-A.5: Criminal Record Check

5311.A.5. A record for each paid and non-paid staff person, including substitutes and foster grandparents shall be on file at the center. Personnel record shall include documentation of a satisfactory criminal record check, as required by R.S.15:587.1. Provider shall request this clearance prior to the employment of any center staff. A criminal record clearance is not transferable from one employer to another. No staff with a criminal conviction of a felony, a plea of guilty or nolo contendere of a felony, or any offense of a violent or sexual nature, or any offense involving a juvenile victim shall be employed in a Class "A" child care center.

Finding:

5311.A.5. Documentation of a satisfactory criminal record check, as required by Louisiana R.S. 15:587.1, was not available for 5 of 19 staff. Documentation of submission was available.

5312-E.3: PFA

5312.E.3. A minimum of at least 50 percent of all staff on the premises and accessible to children shall have documentation of current pediatric first aid certification. Original cards shall be made available upon request. This certification shall be approved by the Department of Social Services prior to acceptance.

Finding:

5312.E.3. The Provider did not have documentation that at least 50 percent of the staff on the premises and accessible to children at all times has current approved Pediatric First Aid training. One of 15 staff had documentation of this certification. Provider has documentation that 10 staff members have recently taken the course; she expects to receive the cards soon.

5321-J: Daily Observation of Children

5321.J. Upon arrival at the center, each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises, injuries, physical condition, etc. When noted, results including an explanation from parent and/or child shall be documented.

Finding:

5321.J. The provider did not document observations noted on children upon arrival to the center. Results including an explanation from parent and/or child were not documented. Some entries do not include an explanation.

5327-P: Visual Check of Center

5327.P. The entire center shall be checked after the last child departs to ensure that no child is left unattended at the center. Documentation shall include date, time, and signature of staff conducting the visual check.

Finding:

5327.P. The Provider did not document that the entire center is checked at the end of the day to ensure that no child is left unattended at the center. Entries were missing for several days.
