

Statement of Deficiencies

1721-A. - C.: Continuing Education Training

Not Met

1721-A. - C.: Early learning centers shall provide opportunities for continuing education of staff members. The center staff of Type III centers, excluding Foster Grandparents, shall obtain a minimum of 12 clock hours of training annually in the topics found in §1719(A) and (B) conducted by trainers approved by the Licensing Division. The Licensing Division shall keep a registry of approved trainers.

B. These Hours are in addition to the 3 hours required for health and safety.

C. Copies of certificates of completion or attendance records shall be maintained at the center and available for inspection by the Licensing Division upon request.

Finding:

1721-A. - C. Based on record review: There was no documentation that the center staff of Type III centers, excluding Foster Grandparents, obtained a minimum of 12 clock hours of training annually in the topics found in §1719(A) and (B) conducted by trainers approved by the Licensing Division, S3, S4 and S6 did not have all required training hours for the anniversary person of June 2016-August 2017. S1 states that the staff is scheduled to goto a conference on July 21-22 2017, S1 has been advised that the hours will count towards the next anniversary year training hours. This is in addition to the required training from the Department of Health, Pediatric First Aid and Infant/Child/Adult CPR.
