1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

Based on observation and record review: On 6/24/2019 at 2:30 PM, Specialist observed that fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, did not have current certification in adult CPR and infant and child CPR. Only 2 of 10 staff present had current CPR certification. 2 additional staff were needed to have current certification in adult CPR and infant and child CPR to be in compliance.

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid Not Met

Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

Based on observation and record review: On 6/24/2019 at 2:30 PM, Specialist observed that fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, did not have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department. Only 2 of 10 staff present had current Pediatric First Aid training. 2 additional staff were needed to have current certification in Pediatric First Aid to be in compliance.
