## 1711.A.&B.&F.&G.: Child to Staff Ratio

Not Met

1711.A.&B.&F.&G.:

- A. Child to staff ratios are established to ensure the safety of all children.
- B. Minimum child to staff ratios shall be met at all times.
- 1. There shall be a minimum of two staff members present at an early learning center when more than one child is present.
- 2. Only those staff members directly providing care, supervision or guidance to children shall be counted in the child to staff ratios.
- F. Minimum Child to Staff Ratios for Type I centers:

G. Mixed Age Groups - Minimum Child to Staff Ratios

- 1. An average of the child to staff ratios may be applied to mixed age groups of children ages 2, 3, 4 and 5.
- 2. Child to staff ratios for children under age two are excluded from averaging.
- 3. When a mixed age group includes children younger than age two, the age of the youngest child determines the child to staff ratio for the group.
- 4. An average may be applied to a mixed age group consisting only of children ages 5 and older.

## Finding:

1711.A.&B.&F.&G.: Based on record review and interview with S1 on 6/25/19 at 3:00pm there failed to have been a minimum of two staff members present at early learning center when more than one child is present as evidenced by on 6/24/19 after 5:38pm when there were 4 children ages one year-three years present with only one staff (S6) present and on premises, and on 6/11/19 after 5:36pm when there were 7 children ages one year-four years present with only one staff (S6) present and on the premises.
