

Statement of Deficiencies

1911-I.-J.: Proper Lifting of a Child

Not Met

1911-I.-J.: Staff members shall adhere to proper techniques for lifting a child.

Staff members shall not lift a child by one or both arms.

Finding:

1911-I.-J. Based on observations on 6/26/18, staff did not lift a child using proper lifting techniques as LS observed S8 supervising 3 children (2 yr olds) during the center visit. LS observed at 10:18 am, S8 lifting a child by both forearms (below the shoulders/above the elbows) and lifting the child from the ground and picking him up. LS did not observe the child as being injured due to S8's improper lifting technique.

1915-B.&C: Health Services - Parental Notification

Not Met

1915-B.&C:

B. Reporting. Incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior shall be documented and reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence.

C. Immediate Notification. The parent shall be immediately notified in the following circumstances:

1. blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
2. head or neck or eye injury;
3. human bite that breaks the skin;
4. animal bite;
5. impaled object;
6. broken or dislodged teeth;
7. allergic reaction skin changes (e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.);
8. unusual breathing;
9. symptoms of dehydration;
10. temperature reading over 101° oral, 102° rectal, or 100° axillary; or
11. injury or illness requiring professional medical attention.

Finding:

1915-C: Based on record review/interview(s) on 6/26/18, The provider failed to immediately notify the parent of the following critical incident: On 6/18/18 (Monday) at approximately 10:30 am, while on a field trip to Brownlee Park, C1 (age 6 year old) fell and hit his head. Once S13 was aware of the injury, S13 stated that due to C1 not having any external injuries, S13 failed to contact C1's parent. During the drive to the center C1 vomited and once upon arrival to the center. During this time C1 stated his head was hurting. Per field trip log, C1 was transported back to the center, arriving at 11:51 am. O1 was then notified via phone upon arrival to the center by S13 and was informed to pick C1 up and take him to the doctor. C1 was picked up by O2 and left the center at approximately 2:00pm. Per staff interview(s), O1 stated that C1 had a concussion.
