Finding:

1715-A.4 Based on record review/interview(s): Documentation of a satisfactory fingerprint based criminal background check (CBC) was not available for S2, prior to the individual(s) being present in the childcare facility (1703.A) S2's date of hire is 6/12/2017. S1 stated S2 went and completed fingerprints. S1 did not have documentation of S2 completing a waiver form before working on premises. A receipt was provided but stated a different first name from S2. S1 and S2 completed a waiver during the licensing visit. S1 also provided the satisfactory criminal background check during the licensing visit with the completion date of 06/23/2017. S1 did not have access to pull S2's days worked on premises during the licensing visit as the payroll person was not in.

1725-A.-E.: Medication Management Training

Finding:

1725-A.-E. Based on record review: After July 1, 2016, the provider did not have at least two staff members trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not. S1 stated 3 staff took the class in May 2017 but did not have certification documentation.
