

Statement of Deficiencies

1901-J.-K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

Not Met

1901-J.-K.: J. Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall be kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children.
K. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901-J. Based on observations on 6/27/18: Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications were not kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. Specialists observed diaper rash creams in a storage shelf located in the 2 year old bathroom. Specialists brought it to the attention of S1 and explained the diaper rash creams are considered medications and should be treated as such to keep in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children.

1903-C: Free of Hazards

Not Met

1903-C: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

Finding:

1903-C Based on observations on 6/27/18: The outdoor area was not free of hazards as Specialists observed a large hole underneath a slide in the play yard.
