1901.J.&K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

Not Met

1901.J.&K.: J. Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children.

K. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901.J.: Based on observation at approximately 10:20 a.m., items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, were not kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. Specialist observed C1, seven-years-old, and C2 eight-years-old, spraying disinfectant cleaning spray to wipe and clean the bathroom sink in S25's classroom bathroom. S25 removed the cleaning spray and placed in a locked cabinet.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 6/29/2022, S2 stated she will retrain staff on this regulation, to ensure compliance with this regulation.
