

## **Statement of Deficiencies**

### **1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training**

**Not Met**

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

#### **Finding:**

1725.A.-C. Based on record review: At approximately 1:15pm, the provider failed to have documentation that at least two staff members were trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not. The current medication administration training certificates expired on 3/23/2021. At approximately 1:30pm, Specialist observed, S1, Staff-in-Charge, leave a message with A Gender for Children to schedule medication administration training for staff.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 6/30/2021, S4, Director, stated she will set a 90-day reminder of when the training expires to ensure training is completed timely, to prevent being recited for this deficiency.

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
