Statement of Deficiencies

1507-A: Daily Attendance Records - Children

1507-A: A daily attendance record for children shall be maintained that shall:

- 1. include the child's first and last name, arrival and departure times, and first and last name of person or entity to whom the child is released;
- 2. accurately reflect children on the center premises at any given time; and
- 3. be used to sign in and out if a child leaves and returns to the center during the day.

Finding:

1507-A Based on observations/record review: The center's daily attendance record for children did not accurately reflect the children on the child care premises at any given time as 24 children were present and 26 children were signed in on the log upon Specialist's arrival on 7/5/18.

1903-E.6: Outdoor - Crawlspaces

1903-E.6: Crawlspaces and mechanical, electrical, or other hazardous equipment shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1903-E.6 Based on observations: Crawlspaces are not inaccessible to children as Specialist observed the protective skirting around the center building to be in disrepair. The vinyl siding under the building had been pushed down, not allowing for full protection of children from crawling under the center building. Specialist observed an 8 foot section along the side of the building and a a 1 foot section was totally missing at the right rear corner of the building.

1907-A.1-2: High Chairs

1907-A.1-2:

- 1. The high chair manufacturer's restraint device shall be used when children are sitting in a high chair.
- 2. Children who are either too small or too large to be restrained using the manufacturer's restraint device shall not be placed in a high chair.

Finding:
