

Statement of Deficiencies

7306-D: Daily Rest Period

Not Met

7306-D: Children five years and younger shall have a daily rest period of at least one hour. Providers that serve children in half-day programs are not required to schedule napping periods for these children.

Finding:

7306-D Based on observations/record review: Children 5 years and younger in a full day program were not allowed a daily rest period of at least one hour as C2 was observed by specialist in the after school room during nap time, not taking a nap. C1 was observed lying on a cot during nap time while all the other children in the room were playing, watching tv, and making noise. C2 did not lye on a cot during nap time.
