- D. A licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

Finding:

1725-A.-D. Based on record review on 7/9/18, S1 failed to have current documentation of training in medication administration completed with an approved Child Care Health Consultant for at least two staff members. Training is required every two years and S1's training expired 6/14/18. LS observed there were no staff members currently trained in medication administration during the center visit.
