

Statement of Deficiencies

1723-A.-B.: CPR Certification

Not Met

1723-A.-B.: A - Infant and child CPR - Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR.

B - Adult CPR - Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR.

Finding:

1723-A.-B. Based on record review: The Provider did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR. 1 of 4 staff had documentation of this certification. S1 is the only staff with CPR certification, but left the premises at 12:43pm, which no staff with CPR certification.

1723-C.-D.: Pediatric First Aid

Not Met

1723-C.-D.:

C. Pediatric First Aid - Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in Pediatric First Aid.

D. Certification - A copy of the certification for each such staff member shall be on-site at all times and available for inspection by the Licensing Division.

Finding:

1723-C.-D. Based on record review: The Provider did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid. 1 of 4 staff had documentation of this certification. S1 is the only staff Pediatric First Aid certification, but left the premises at 12:43pm, which left no staff with Pediatric First Aid certification.

1807-B.: CCCBC-Based Determinations of Eligibility for Volunteers and Staff

Not Met

1807-B.: B. Volunteers and Staff. An early learning center shall obtain a CCCBC-based determination of eligibility for child care purposes from the department for each volunteer, staff member, or employee of any kind, and shall have documentation of said determination available at all times for inspection upon request by the Licensing Division.

Finding:

1807-B. Based on record review: A CCCBC-based determination of eligibility for child care purposes from the department was not obtained for S1, prior to the person's Right to Review, dated 6/2/17, expiring on 6/2/18. S1 has been present at the center every business day since the expiration date of the Right to Review. S1 submitted documentation to receive a CCCBC during the visit and left the premises at 12:43 pm. The Specialists also observed that there was not CCCBC documentation for two volunteers (O1 & O2), who were being supervised by S2, on file.
