# Statement of Deficiencies

## 1909-C: Infants - Positioning Devices

1909-C: Infants shall not be placed in positioning devices, unless the center has written authorization from a physician to use a positioning device.

#### Finding:

1909-C Based on observations: Written authorization from a physician was available for C1 to use a positioning device for sleeping, but stipulates C1 is to sleep in a bed and not be positioned with a pillow. C1 was observed sleeping on the floor with a pillow as a positioning device.

## 1919-A&B: Food Service and Nutrition - Menu

1919-A&B: All meals and snacks provided by the center, and their preparation, service and storage, shall meet the requirements for meals of the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) and 7 C.F.R. 226.20 and the Louisiana Sanitary Code, Title 51, Part XXIII, found at LAC 51:XXXIII. For the current CACFP meal patterns, contact the Louisiana Department of Education, Division of Nutrition Support.

The weekly menu shall:

- 1. be planned for each day of the week and list the specific food items served;
- 2. be prominently posted by the first day of each week and remain <b>posted</b> throughout the week; and
- 3. have substitutions or additions posted on or near the menu.

## Finding:

1919-A&B Based on Observations: Center failed to change their weekly menu indicating the planned meals for each day until the Wednesday of the current week. Center changed the menu during inspection, deficiency cleared.
