CPR Certification: Based on record review: On 7/16/18 the center did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR. 3 of 7staff had documentation of this certification. The center required 4 trained staff in the infant in child CPR to be in compliance with the regulation.
