

## ***Statement of Deficiencies***

### **1917.B.: Medication Authorization - Required Container/Packaging**

**Not Met**

1917.B.: Required Container/Packaging

1. For prescription medication to be administered at the center, the center shall maintain the original pharmacy container with the complete pharmacy label.
2. For non-prescription medication to be administered, the center shall maintain the original bottle packing for the medicine or a printed document from the manufacturer's website, which shall include the drug name and strength and clear directions for use.

#### **Finding:**

1917.B. Based on observations/Record Review: The prescription medication to be administered at the center was not in the original pharmacy container with the complete pharmacy label. On 7/17/19 at approximately 12:30pm, Specialist reviewed medication in the center. C1 had an EpiPen that was not in the original pharmacy container with the complete pharmacy label. Director contacted C1's Mother to bring the original container while Specialist was still in the center.

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
