1915.B.&C.: Health Services - Parental Notification

Not Met

1915.B.&C.:

B. Reporting. Incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior shall be documented and reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence.

C. Immediate Notification. The parent shall be immediately notified in the following circumstances:

- 1. blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
- 2. head or neck or eye injury;
- 3. human bite that breaks the skin;
- 4. animal bite;
- 5. impaled object;
- 6. broken or dislodged teeth;
- 7. allergic reaction skin changes (e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.);
- 8. unusual breathing;
- 9. symptoms of dehydration;
- 10. temperature reading over 101° oral, 102° rectal, or 100° axillary, or
- 11. injury or illness requiring professional medical attention.

Finding:

1915:B&C: Based on interviews on 7/21/2020, at 10:15 AM, center staff did not have documentation of an incident that occurred on 6/22/2020 in which C2, one year old, sat on C1's, one year old, legs after C1 attempted to take a toy from him. S4 stated she did not document the incident because C1 began running and playing and did not appear to be hurt.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 7/21/2020, S1 stated she will speak with her staff to ensure they document these types of incidents as well as soon as possible to ensure this is not cited again.
