

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

#### Finding:

1725.A.-C. Based on record review: On 7/23/2020 at 12:30pm, Specialist reviewed staff records, and observed S1 did not have at least two staff members trained in medication administration, whether the early learning center administers medication or not. S9 is the only staff trained to administer medication with an expiration of 4/9/2021. A review of C1's, age 2, medication authorization form showed S2, not trained, documented that she administered prescription medication to C1 nine times from 6/16/2020 to 6/26/2020.

Corrective Action Plan: S1 stated she scheduled a training on 7/25/2020, at 8:30am, and all staff not trained will attend. S1 will ensure S9 is the only staff who administers medication until additional staff are trained.

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
