1507-A: A daily attendance record for children shall be maintained that shall:

- 1. include the child's first and last name, arrival and departure times, and first and last name of person or entity to whom the child is released;
- 2. accurately reflect children on the center premises at any given time; and
- 3. be used to sign in and out if a child leaves and returns to the center during the day.

Finding:

1507-A Based on record review: The center's daily attendance record for children did not accurately reflect the children on the child care premises at any given time as 30 children were present and 27 children were signed in on the log. All children were accounted for and record was updated during Licensing visit.

1919-D.3.&4.: Food Service and Nutrition - Reasonable Time and Food Served

1919-D.3.&4.: 3. Children shall be allowed a reasonable time to eat each meal and snack. Children shall not be forced to finish all their food.4. Food shall be given to children on individual plates, cups, napkins, or paper towels, as appropriate, and individual utensils shall be provided, as appropriate.

Finding:

1919-D.4: Based on observations: Children's food was not served on individual plates, cups, napkins or paper towels as appropriate and individual utensils shall be provided, as appropriate. Specialist observed one 8 month old child eating directly off the tray attached to the chair.
