

Statement of Deficiencies

1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725.A.-C. Based on record review: S1 did not have at least two staff members trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not. S1 is currently the only staff member trained in medication administration, with her certification set to expire at the end of July 2020.

Corrective Action Plan - S1 stated she will immediately contact Agenda for Children/Child Care Resources to schedule a Medication Administration course for two staff with a CCHC by 8/21/2020.
