

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1907-A.1-2: High Chairs

Not Met

1907-A.1-2:

1. The high chair manufacturer's restraint device shall be used when children are sitting in a high chair.
2. Children who are either too small or too large to be restrained using the manufacturer's restraint device shall not be placed in a high chair.

#### Finding:

1907-A.1-2 Based on observations/interview(s): The high chair manufacturer's restraint device was not used when children are sitting in a high chair. Specialist observed that in the one year old class, 6 of 6 children seated at a high chair table and 7 of 7 children seated in high chairs during lunch failed to have a restraint in use. S1, S7, and S8 corrected prior to Specialist departure.

### 1911-K: Hand Washing

Not Met

1911-K: Staff and children shall wash their hands using soap at least at the following times: upon arrival at the center, before preparing or serving meals, before giving medication, after playing in water used by more than one person, after toileting, after helping a child use a toilet or changing diapers, after wiping noses or cleaning wounds, after handling pets and other animals, after playing in sandboxes, before eating meals or snacks, upon coming in from outdoors, after cleaning or handling garbage and anytime hands become soiled with body fluids, such as urine, saliva, blood or nasal discharge.

#### Finding:

1911-K Based on observations/interview(s): Children did not wash their hands with soap and water as needed. Licensing Specialist observed a two year old child use the potty and return to the lunch table without washing his hands. S6 stated she was about to provide the child with a wet wipe to clean his hands. Specialist advised S1 and S6 that children must wash their hands with soap and water after using the potty. S1 stated that she is aware of this and directed the child to wash his hands properly.
