- 1. child abuse identification and reporting;
- 2. emergency preparation;
- 3. licensing regulations; and
- 4. safe sleep practices.
- B. Within 30 calendar days of date of hire, each staff member shall receive orientation to the additional policies and practices of the center that at a minimum shall include:
 - 1. child development;
 - 2. child guidance;
 - 3. learning activities;
 - 4. health and safety;
 - 5. shaken baby prevention; and
 - 6. CPR and first aid, as applicable.

Finding:

1719.A.&B: Based on record review and interviews on 07/30/19 at 12:06PM S1 lacked documentation that 1 of 11 staff, S9, received orientation within seven days of the first day present at the center and prior to having sole responsibility for any children. S1 lacked documentation that 1 of 11 staff, S9, received additional orientation within thirty days of date of hire.

1903.C.: Free of Hazards Not Met

1903.C.: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

Finding:

1903.C. Based on observations on 07/30/19 at 11:27AM, the outdoor play area were not free of hazards as evidenced by specialist observed a water hose lying on the walkway leading to the playground. S1 wrapped the water hose up while specialist was present. The bicycle merry-go-round is missing three pedals. S1 stated they will put some new pedals on the bicycle merry-go-round.

2101.A.3.: Capacity of Vehicle

2101.A.3.: The number of persons in a vehicle shall not exceed the manufacturer's recommended capacity

Finding:

2101.A.3. Based on record review on 07/30/19 at 12:45PM, S1 exceeded the manufacturer's recommended capacity in the vehicle as evidenced by 13 children and 3 adults transported in a 15 passenger vehicle for a field trip dated 06/13/19 to McDonald's.
